During the tour Little Owls are photographed in a natural and lively setting.

ITINERARY

Day 1 Arrival to Amsterdam

Arrival to Amsterdam in the afternoon. Local guide will pick you up from airport. About two hours to Barchem. Dinner at accommodation. Evening photography session with Barn Owls.

Days 2 - 3

Morning starts with early photography session with Little Owls. Late breakfast after morning session.

Early Dinner at 15.00. Departure to second session with Little Owls. Departure to Barn Owl hide at 18.00. Rest of the evening Barn Owl photography. Evening snack in the hide.

Day 4

In the last morning you have the last photography session with Little Owls before late breakfast and departure to the airport.

Thrilling Barn Owl experience

Finnature owners Jari and Kaisa visited this place in July 2017 and had great photography opportunities. Barn Owls were breeding in a local farm and they were able to photograph mainly the adult birds coming to the beautiful setup which was lit by studio lights.

The shed features spotlights (white balance: daylight) that create an inteteresting experience during darkness. This makes the Barn Owl setting particularly unique and thrilling.

Local guide will use mice (dead) to attract the Owls and before you know, adult Barn Owl comes to get easy food for the young ones. During July young ones are busy exploring the attic and practicing their flying skills. A little bit clumsy, the birds hiss and shake their heads like ghosts in the dark. In the distance sounds the alarm call of Blackbird and elsewhere Little Owl screeches. A night to remember!

Duration of a session is normally 4 hours, from 20.00 – 24.00. This might seem long but we ensure that the time flies. Because of the observant nature of the Barn Owls, we strongly encourage visitors to wear dark (preferably black) clothing.

The location and hide have been rated 5/5 stars (source: 'Vogelbescherming Nederland').

We advise to bring:

- Tripod head
- Lens (between 150-500mm)
- Charged batteries
- Charger (electricity is present in the hut)



Little Owls in a natural setting

While visiting in this place in summer 2017, Little Owl family visited a garden regularly. After only a little wait, several Owls visited straight in front of the hide using different posts for perching. Little Owls came to look for food put up for them (dead mice and insects). This place offered also good chances for flight shots of Little Owls.

Actually, a few Little Owls have made their home on a terrain of a small farm near Borculo. They have bred there for many years in a nest box which is located in an old chestnut tree. Little Owls can be photographed from a hide in the rough meadows near the chestnut tree.

The setting appears very natural as it is, but some attractive perches have been added. The perches will be frequently changed to keep the setting lively and exciting.

Aside from Little owls, a family of Great Tits, Redstarts, Great-spotted Woodpeckers and even Green Woodpeckers can be frequently spotted at this location.

Morning and afternoon sessions in this hide.

- Tripod head

- Lens (between 150-600mm)

- Charged batteries

- Charger (electricity is present in the hut)
